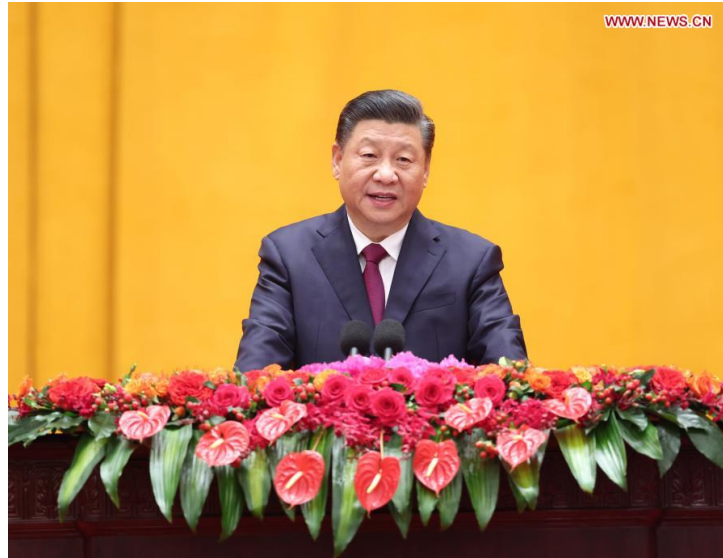


Xi Jinping Extends Spring Festival Greetings to Leaders

BEIJING, Feb. 11 (Xinhua)– Chinese President and CPC Central Committee General Secretary Xi Jinping on Wednesday extended Spring Festival greetings to members of non-CPC political parties, the All-China Federation of Industry and Commerce (ACFIC), personages without party

affiliation, and other united front members.

Xi conveyed his greetings while attending the annual gathering with non-CPC personages at the Great Hall of the People in Beijing.
