MIRPUR (AJK), February 19 – Preparations are complete across Azad Jammu and Kashmir (AJK),

IIOJK Pakistan, and the United Kingdom to observe the 53rd martyrdom anniversary of Kashmiri

London martyrs Hanif Shaheed and Basharat Shaheed on February 20, Friday. The
