MIRPUR (AJK), March 5: A state-of-the-art mosque and a spacious hall were inaugurated late

Wednesday at the Faculty of Health & Medical Sciences (FH&MS) of the public-sector Mirpur

University of Science & Technology (MUST), it was officially said.

The newly established Dewan Begum Mosque and Dr. Zarish Nawaz Hall are being described as a
