MIRPUR (AJK), March 16 – Azad Jammu & Kashmir Prime Minister Faisal Mumtaz Rathore said promoting the education and recitation of the Holy Quran remains a key priority of his government. He made the remarks while addressing a high-level meeting of the Tajweed-ul-Quran Trust at Jammu Kashmir House, stressing the importance of religious education in
