All arrangements have been finalized across Azad Jammu and Kashmir to celebrate Pakistan Day on March 23 with traditional enthusiasm, renewed commitment, and special ceremonies across

the region.

The day will be marked with flag-hoisting ceremonies in all major and small cities of Azad Jammu and Kashmir, with main events scheduled in district headquarters including Muzaffarabad, Mirpur, Kotli, Bhimber, Bagh, Rawalakot, Neelum Valley, Hattian, Haveli, and Sudhnoti.

Pakistan's national flag will be hoisted on public and private buildings, while various social, political, and public organizations have planned special programmes to mark the historic day.

Cultural events, patriotic rallies, and public gatherings will also highlight the celebrations.

Special programmes highlighting the historical importance of Pakistan Day will be broadcast by Azad Jammu and Kashmir Radio stations in Mirpur, Muzaffarabad, and Tararkhel, as well as AJK Television. Special messages from the Acting President of Azad Jammu and Kashmir and the Prime

Minister of Azad Jammu and Kashmir will also be broadcast on the occasion, inspiring renewed unity and patriotism across the region.
