Islamabad, March 29 (QNA) – Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs of Pakistan, Mohammad Ishaq Dar, met with Egypt’s Minister of Foreign Affairs, Badr Abdelatty, to discuss regional developments in the Middle East, including efforts to de-escalate tensions and promote a path toward calm.

The two ministers also exchanged views on regional and international developments,
