## Qatar Amir, UAE President Hold Talks on Regional and International Developments

Abu Dhabi, March 31 (QNA) – HH the Amir Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad Al-Thani has held talks with

HH President of the United Arab Emirates Sheikh Mohamed bin Zayed Al Nahyan in Abu Dhabi,

focusing on recent regional and international developments and efforts to restore stability.

During the meeting on Tuesday, the two leaders discussed the rapidly evolving developments in

the region, including ongoing tensions linked to Iranian attacks and their wider security

implications. They also examined the impact of recent events on global energy supplies and market stability.

HH the Amir emphasized the importance of prioritizing diplomatic solutions to resolve conflicts, highlighting the need for strengthened cooperation to safeguard regional security and limit the global repercussions of ongoing crises.

The talks also covered bilateral relations between Qatar and the United Arab Emirates, with both sides stressing the importance of continued coordination and consultation across key issues, reflecting the strong fraternal ties and strategic partnership between the two nations.
