

Trump Urges Allies to Secure Strait of Hormuz

Donald Trump has urged the United Kingdom and other allies to “go to the Strait of Hormuz and just take” Iranian oil, a statement that has drawn widespread attention amid ongoing regional tensions.

The former president's increasingly impatient tone, including criticism of France as "VERY UNHELPFUL," highlights the pressure he faces as tensions continue to affect global energy security and regional stability.
