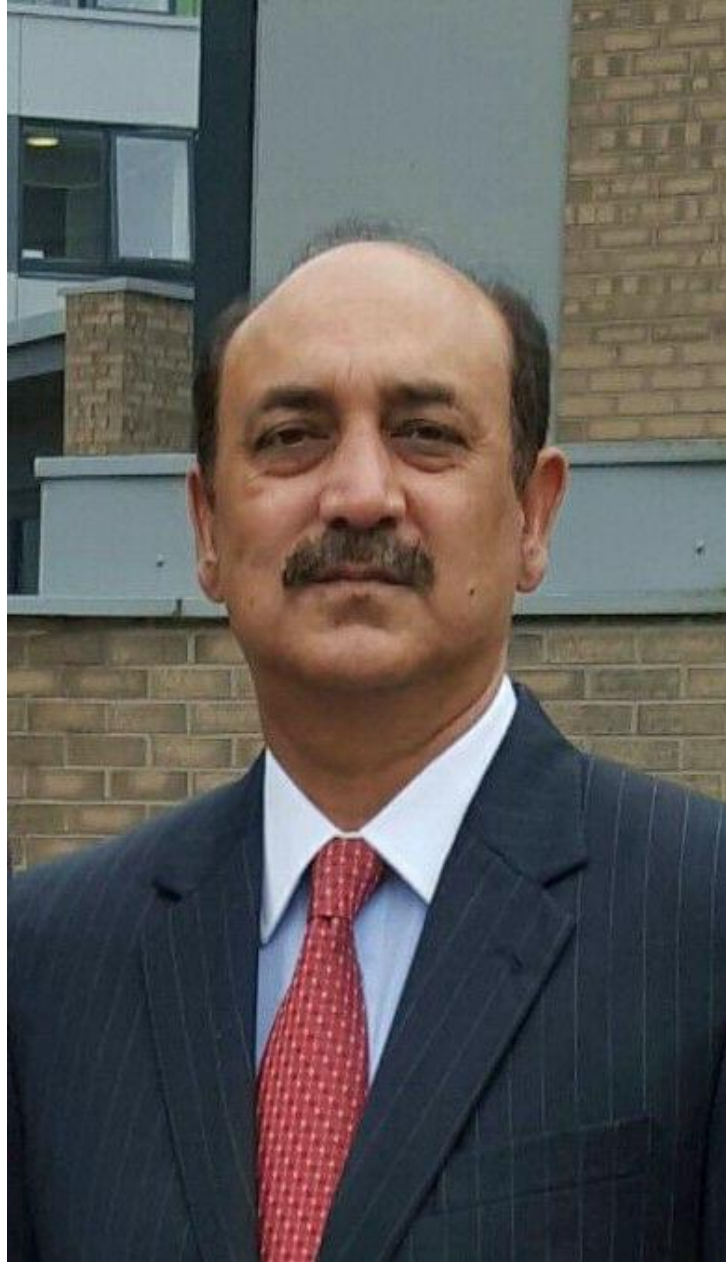


Pakistan's Peace Doctrine
