Doha, April 21 (QNA) – HH the Amir Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad Al-Thani received a phone call on Tuesday from HE Prime Minister of Japan Sanae Takaichi.

Discussions addressed bilateral cooperation and ways to support and further develop it. The two sides also reviewed regional and international developments, particularly the ongoing escalation and its impact on energy markets and supply chains, and stressed the importance of maintaining

stable energy flows.
