

US Says Nears Draft Iran War Agreement Framework

The United States is reportedly close to finalizing a one-page memorandum of understanding aimed at ending the ongoing conflict involving Iran, according to Axios, citing two U.S. officials and other sources briefed on the matter.

The proposed framework is said to outline a declaration to end hostilities and initiate a 30-day negotiation period focused on broader regional arrangements. These would include reopening

strategic maritime routes, limiting Iran's nuclear programme, and discussing the possible lifting of U.S. sanctions.

Sources suggest the draft represents the most advanced stage of negotiations since the conflict began, marking a potential turning point after months of escalation and heightened regional tensions.

The report indicates Washington is currently awaiting Iran's response on several key provisions within the next 48 hours. Officials believe Tehran's position will determine whether the framework advances into structured negotiations or stalls at the preliminary stage.

If agreed, the memorandum would serve as a foundation for a broader political and security settlement, potentially easing tensions across multiple regional fronts and stabilizing key maritime and energy corridors important to global trade.

Diplomatic observers note that while progress appears significant, major gaps remain between both sides regarding implementation procedures, monitoring mechanisms, and long-term verification measures required for sustained compliance.
