Doha, May 17 (QNA) – HE Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs Sheikh Mohammed bin Abdulrahman bin Jassim Al-Thani, held a telephone call with HE Prime Minister of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, Mohammad Shahbaz Sharif.
