DOHA, May 18, 2026— The National Human Rights Committee in cooperation with the Ministry of Municipality organized an awareness workshop for workers and staff of the committee, focusing on waste sorting from the source and the Public Cleanliness Law.

The workshop, conducted by the Public Hygiene Department's Awareness and Education Section,
