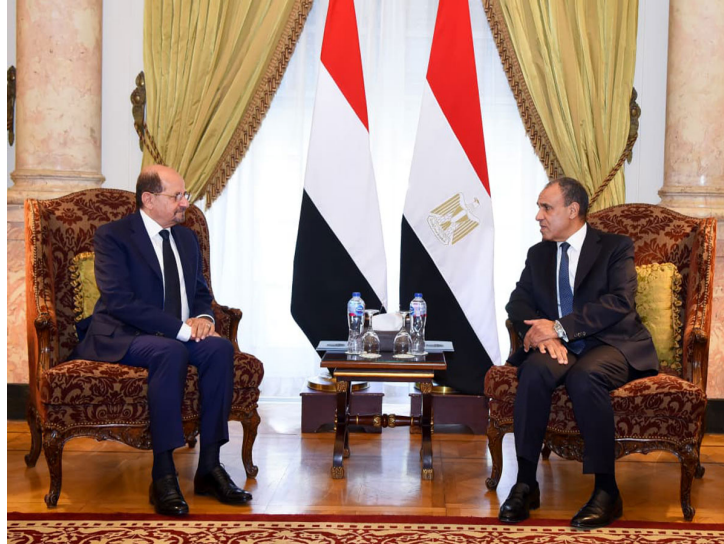


Egypt, Yemen Hold Talks on Regional Developments, Red Sea Security

Cairo, May 24 (QNA) – Egyptian Foreign Minister Badr Abdelatty met today with Yemeni Prime Minister and Foreign Minister Shaya Mohsen Al-Zindani to discuss regional developments and ways to strengthen bilateral relations.
