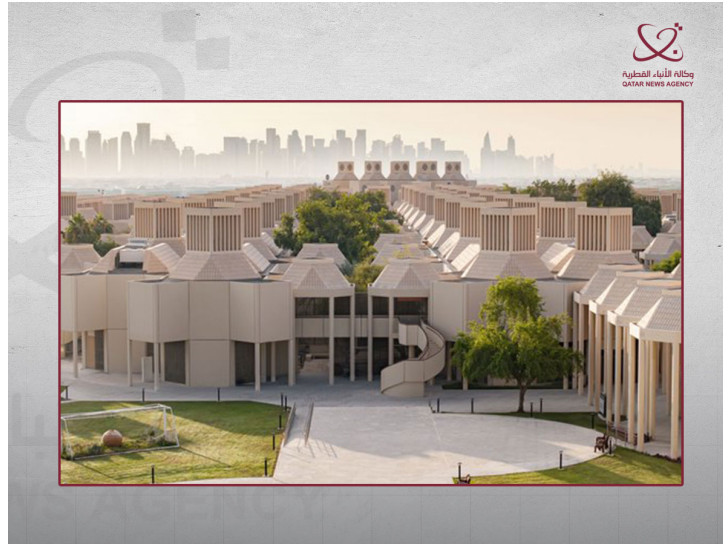

QU Celebrates Graduation New Cohort of Early Childhood Center
