
U.S. May Reimpose Sanctions on Russian Oil Soon

EVIAN, France, June 16—U.S. President Donald Trump said on Tuesday that the United States could soon reimpose sanctions on Russian oil, Xinhua reported.

Speaking in Evian during international engagements, Trump suggested Washington is reviewing policy options on Russian energy exports amid ongoing geopolitical tensions. He did not provide a timeline or specific details of any potential measures.

The remarks come as Western governments continue reassessing economic pressure on Moscow linked to the conflict in Ukraine. Energy markets remain sensitive to any signals of tighter restrictions on Russian oil, a key component of global supply.

Xinhua reported that Trump's comments reflect growing political debate in Washington over strengthening sanctions enforcement, although no formal policy decision has been announced.

The White House has not issued any confirmation of imminent changes to sanctions policy.

Analysts say any renewed restrictions on Russian oil exports could affect global energy prices and supply stability, particularly in Europe and Asia.

Further clarification is expected as U.S. officials outline next steps in the coming days.
