New York, July 02 (QNA)– The State of Qatar, represented by the National Counter-Terrorism Committee, participated in the United Nations Counter-Terrorism Week, which was held in New York City, USA, from Jun. 26 to Jul. 2, 2026.

On the sidelines of the week’s activities, the Qatari delegation held a meeting with UN Executive Director of the Counter-Terrorism Executive Directorate Natalia Gherman.
