
PML-N Pledges Development and Public Welfare Agenda for AJK: Saeed



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MIRPUR (AJK), July 16: Former AJK minister and Pakistan Muslim League-Nawaz (PML-N) leader

Chaudhry Muhammad Saeed has said that his party remains committed to public service, development and prosperity in Azad Jammu and Kashmir, describing PML-N as a symbol of hope for the people.
