
China Opens Traditional Medicine Clinic at Rwanda Hospital



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KIGALI, July 16: A traditional Chinese medicine (TCM) clinic has opened at Kibungo Hospital in eastern Rwanda, marking another step in the health cooperation between Rwanda and China.
