Doha, July 19 (QNA) – HH the Amir Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad Al-Thani held official talks with HE

Prime Minister of the sisterly Republic of Iraq, Ali Faleh Al-Zaidi, at Lusail Palace on Sunday.

At the outset of the talks, HH the Amir welcomed the Iraqi Prime Minister and his accompanying
