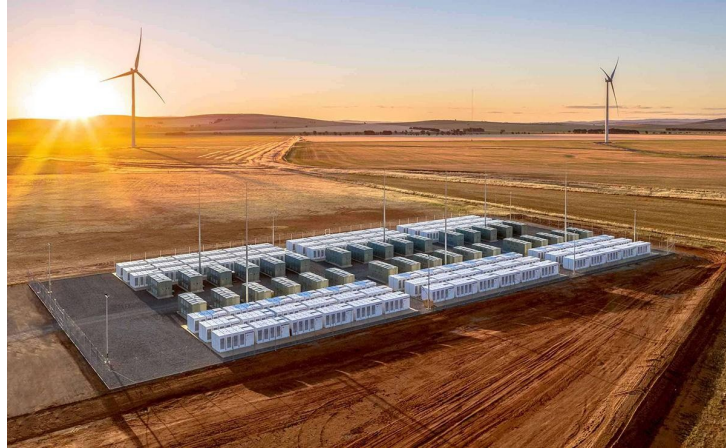

China Supported Wind Power Project Completed in Uzbekistan
