

AJK BISE invites Class 10 candidates for answer-sheet rechecking

MIRPUR (AJK), August 25: The Azad Jammu and Kashmir Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education (AJKBISE) Mirpur has invited candidates who appeared in the Secondary First Annual Examination 2026, Class 10th/Composite, to apply for rechecking of their answer sheets under prescribed rules.

The examination results were announced on August 18, 2026. Candidates seeking rechecking can apply through the E-Services portal on the board's official website by selecting the "Paper Rechecking" option.

Candidates must first generate a challan with their correct roll number, name and other particulars. The rechecking fee is Rs1,500 per paper. Candidates seeking rechecking of more than one paper must generate a challan for the required number of papers.

The challan category is SSC – Paper Rechecking. Fees can be deposited through 1-Bill, HBL app, Easypaisa or JazzCash. After payment, candidates must complete the online application using the challan number and provide a valid email address.

The online application facility will remain available until September 1, 2026. Candidates are advised to submit their applications and pay the prescribed fee by the deadline.

Those facing difficulties with the online process may submit a manual application. The fee can be deposited through a money order at post offices within Azad Kashmir, with the original receipt attached to the application.

Application forms are available from the board's head office and regional liaison offices in Muzaffarabad and Rawalakot.

Candidates can check their application status online through the challan number and will receive details regarding paper inspection through their registered email address.

The Controller of Examinations urged candidates to complete the process by September 1 to avoid inconvenience.
