Doha, June 12 (QNA)—Assistant Undersecretary for Social Development Affairs at the Ministry of Social Development and Family Fahd bin Mohammed Al Khayarin opened the awareness-raising art exhibition 'Resilience', organized by the Center for Empowerment and Care of the Elderly (Ehsan) at the Cultural Village on the occasion of World Elder Abuse Awareness Day.

The exhibition highlights the suffering of the older persons in Palestine and the Gaza Strip in particular, especially in light of the difficult circumstances through which Palestinians in the occupied Palestinian territories are going.
