PTI leader re-arrested from Islamabad

Amir Mughal, the President of Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) Islamabad, has been arrested again by the police. The arrest took place outside the Deputy Commissioner's office, confirmed PTI lawyer Asim Baig. The reasons for Amir Mughal's re-arrest remain unclear.
